Amid multiple health challenges, Bill McKelvie is taking on his 80s with a smile. Living with COPD and heart failure, Bill is no stranger to the QEII’s emergency department. As a world-leader in COPD and the advanced heart health centre in Atlantic Canada, the QEII is here for patients like Bill in those moments.

Bill arrived at the QEII by ambulance in April 2017 after experiencing difficulty breathing. When his heart attack hit, he was in the emergency department.

“*He’s had his share of adventures,” says his wife, PremaBae. “We’ve been very fortunate. I know we have a shortage of doctors, but the ones we have are excellent.”*

“The emergency team is fantastic,” Bill says. “When they’re looking after you, you feel completely comfortable. If it wasn’t for them, I wouldn’t be here.”

Grateful for life-saving care, Bill made a donation in honour of his care team.

In 2017-2018, our donor community supported more than \$5.1 million in leading-edge equipment and technology like the StealthStation. When QEII physicians and staff have access to state-of-the-art resources, they are able to provide the best possible care for Atlantic Canadians when they need it most.

When medical experts access innovative technology, **magic happens.**

The QEII's neurosurgery and neurology teams work together to help epilepsy patients get better. When these patients reach the QEII, they want answers. What causes their seizures? Will they ever live seizure-free? While many patients manage their symptoms through medication, sometimes brain surgery is the best option.

The QEII is now home to the StealthStation Surgical Navigation System. The most advanced of its kind, this software guides surgical planning for patients living with epilepsy. Dr. David Clarke, head of the division of neurosurgery, is already seeing the results of this innovation.

“*This technology has an immediate, direct impact on patients and their families. Patients are treated sooner and spend less time on the operating table, and surgeons have access to the technology to guide pre-operative planning for these surgeries. There are many Atlantic Canadians that we have yet to treat. That’s where the big impact is – we’ll help more patients find answers and improve their quality of life by reducing or, in many cases, eliminating their seizures. We wouldn’t have access to this technology without community support. **It is what separates a place that can do good work from a place of excellence.**”*

Connecting to what matters most

Since the Stay Connected Mental Health Project began five years ago, coordinator Debbie Phillips (right) and her team have implemented new guidelines and principles into daily practice, trained peer support workers like Tanaka Shumba (left), and worked closely with Halifax's five universities to provide students with better access to mental health care.

“*Growing up in Zimbabwe, mental health was not talked about. So when I arrived in Halifax for university two years ago, my own experience was very unexpected. I was on my own for the first time, half a world away from my family, adapting to a new culture and very immersed in my studies. It all became very stressful. After receiving the help I needed, I became very passionate about mental health and applied to become a peer support worker with the Stay Connected Mental Health Project. It's been a very rewarding experience, providing a safe space, a listening ear and support to my fellow students.*”

On September 30, 2017, *Ride for Cancer* powered by BMO Bank of Montreal did something BIGGER for cancer care in our region. With 475 riders, over 200 volunteers, valued sponsors, and supporters, our Ride community raised \$607,913 net. These critical funds will provide advanced therapy equipment to double capacity and shorten wait times for cancer patients at the QEII, fund local research unlocking new treatments for leukemia patients, and support patients and families through our partnership with The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada.

Giving back to QEII patients through *Ride for Cancer*

As a program manager at the QEII's Nova Scotia Rehabilitation and Arthritis Centre, Joanne Comeau's focus is on the treatment and care provided to people with spinal cord injuries and neurological issues, helping patients regain as much of their independence as possible. Her dedication to QEII patients stems far beyond those she sees every day.

“*Ride for Cancer doesn't necessarily impact the majority of patients in my work area but it does impact QEII cancer patients. We all know patients, co-workers, family or friends that have cancer and that's why it is important for me to give back. As a healthcare worker or administrator, we all strive to provide the best care possible to our patients. That's the goal of Ride for Cancer - improving cancer care in our region. If I can volunteer my time to help QEII patients, why wouldn't I?*”

My volunteer role at the Ride was as the lead contact for first aid. I remember the energy and excitement on event day from the other volunteers, spectators, and of course the riders. It was an amazing experience that I think everyone should get involved with. No matter how big or small your part is, we are all working together to improve patient treatment and care at the QEII.”

In 2017-2018, thanks to the generosity of donors, more than \$1.9 million was invested in QEII research projects. We continue to support excellence in healthcare research through commitments such as \$300,000 for QEII Foundation Translating Research Into Care (TRIC) grants and \$200,000 as part of the inaugural Maritime Heart Centre Innovation Fund for heart health research.

These grants, like the fibromyalgia study, fuel physicians and researchers to advance treatment and improve patient care, providing critical research funding that would otherwise not be available.

Fueling mind over matter **breakthroughs**

A common condition with no known cause or measurable physical symptoms, fibromyalgia is very challenging to diagnose and relentless for patients who live with it.

Fibromyalgia causes widespread chronic pain and tenderness that varies in intensity and can even travel to different parts of the body. A new research study at the QEII will examine the brain's response to pain sensitivity and perception. Funded by a gift from the estate of Abe Leventhal, this leading-edge research aims to improve the diagnosis and treatment of fibromyalgia.

Lead investigators, Dr. Javeria Hashmi (left) and Dr. Mary Lynch (right), are optimistic about the innovative study's potential to impact those living with fibromyalgia, here, in Atlantic Canada and around the world.

“*One of the central issues surrounding chronic pain is the question, ‘is it all in your head?’. Our study uses brain imaging and cognitive testing to understand how the brain contributes to pain sensitivity in fibromyalgia patients. The goal is to establish whether fibromyalgia is associated with a dysfunction in the brain’s systems that control pain intensity in response to expectations – and, ultimately, maximize patients’ capacity for managing their own pain and healing.*”

Our research is very new and very cutting-edge; donors should feel proud about what it could mean for patients living with this condition.”

QEII Cardiac Cath Lab D treats first patients

When inserting a coronary stent or implanting a pacemaker, high resolution images of a patient's heart are critical. That's why a community of donors rallied behind phase one of our *From the Heart* campaign – funding the rebuilding and reopening of the QEII's Cardiac Cath Lab D. Treating its first patients in December 2017, the unparalleled imaging quality and capability of the QEII's newest cath lab is already improving patient outcomes and reducing wait times for vital heart health procedures.

QEII cardiologists, Dr. Hussein Beydoun (left) and Dr. Tony Lee (right), are part of the world-class team responsible for affairs of the heart.

“*When Cardiac Cath Lab D – one of four QEII catheterization labs – was closed due to aging equipment and infrastructure, our team immediately lost 25 per cent of our operating capacity. Our wait lists are always foremost on our minds as lives literally hang in the balance.*”

Donors stepped up and not only funded the rebuilding of the space so we're back at full capacity but also ensured the new lab was equipped with the best imaging technology available. In its lifetime, the new Cardiac Cath Lab D will treat about 25,000 patients and, without a doubt, it will save countless lives.”

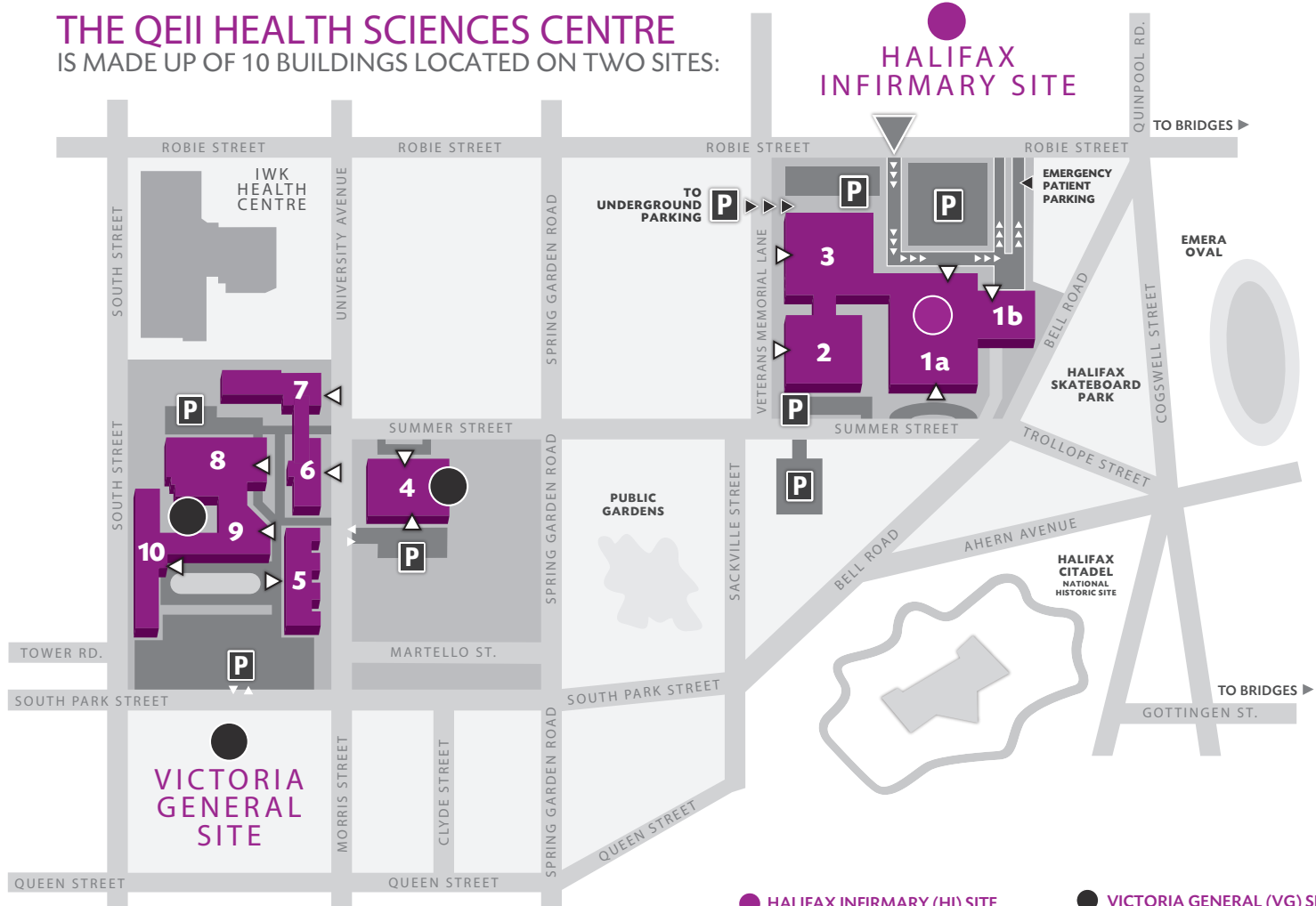
