

Comfort & Care 2023 Funded Items

Comfort & Care grants were established in 2005 to fund smaller items within the QEII Health Sciences Center that otherwise would not be funded by the Health Authority. As of 2023, the Comfort & Care grants have disbursed just over \$1.968m to support items that might otherwise not be funded from existing health center budgets with grants of \$5000 or less. Grants are awarded in the categories of Patient Comforts, Patient and Family Education, Patient and Family Furnishings and Patient Recreation and Activities. This year, updated criteria allowed the inclusion of adult healthcare programs located within our communities. Below is the summary of awarded grants.
